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Program Overview

The Husky Sport After School & Weekend Partnerships served about 100 students from grades K-12 across a range of Hartford area schools. Working with three Hartford community partners, six days a week, Husky Sport provided homework help, structured physical activity, free play while encouraging healthy lifestyle habits. Continuing to build upon relationships between Husky Sport and the families and partners of Hartford's North End community, the After School and Weekend Partnerships aligned with the objectives and practices of Hartford and UConn stakeholders.

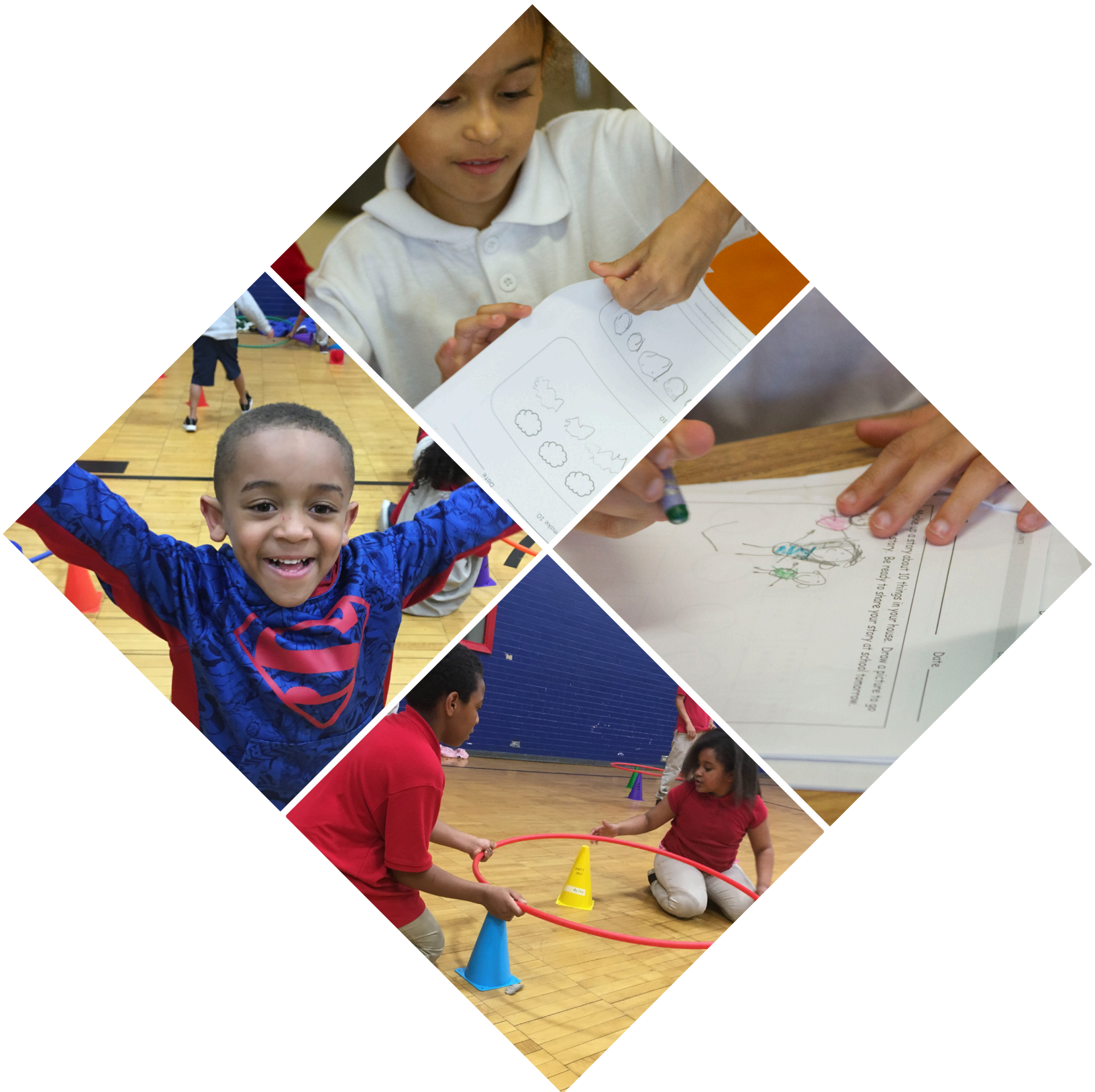
